Recovery Position



The Recovery Position is used when the casualty is U _____ and B _____ but has NO other L ___ threatening conditions.

Steps

1. Place the arm closest to you in the Scout Sign.
2. Place the other hand against their cheek and hold it there. (Don't let go)
3. Lift the knee farthest from you.
4. Roll the casualty towards you by pulling the raised knee.
5. Tilt the head back gently.
6. Pull the knee up to a right angle.



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
